- After half the group met on Zoom and the other on Google Chat due to a virtual meeting invite miscommunication by Fay, all attendees were able to hop onto Zoom for the meeting

Votes

- Bus transport for HS students
 - o HS students from SH do not have a bus and do not fall within the limits
 - A number of parents in the district feel it's an unsafe route, no sidewalk and too long a walk
 - A letter from parents was sent to the BOE on 6/25
 - 9/3 Board responded
 - Kathleen Ryan responded that by law, you have to apply by 3/1 and must be voted for in school budget which is in the spring.
 - Can apply next March 2022, Board would need to do a study to determine that it's a child safety zone.
 - o Admin, BOE considering and discussing it
 - Can HS kids board MS busses? Pandemic, HS students could not get on bus due to social distancing rules

- Can PTA help with solution building?
- Can we put out a poll to find out who this impacts
- BOE forced to fulfill need if enough parents are onboard?
 - Need more info, must be physical signatures on petition
- YES vote, move forward with helping, 2 abstains
- Screen time MS, accessing personal devices and social media in class
 - What firewalls are up? Certain teachers monitoring this, but needs to be a consistent policy - no permission to use devices during school
 - Committee Technology? can HeadsUp take part?
 - o Advocate for parent concern YES
 - o Need firewall for school district device?
 - Parents need more awareness
 - Advocating for stricter monitoring of school issued devices not personal devices
